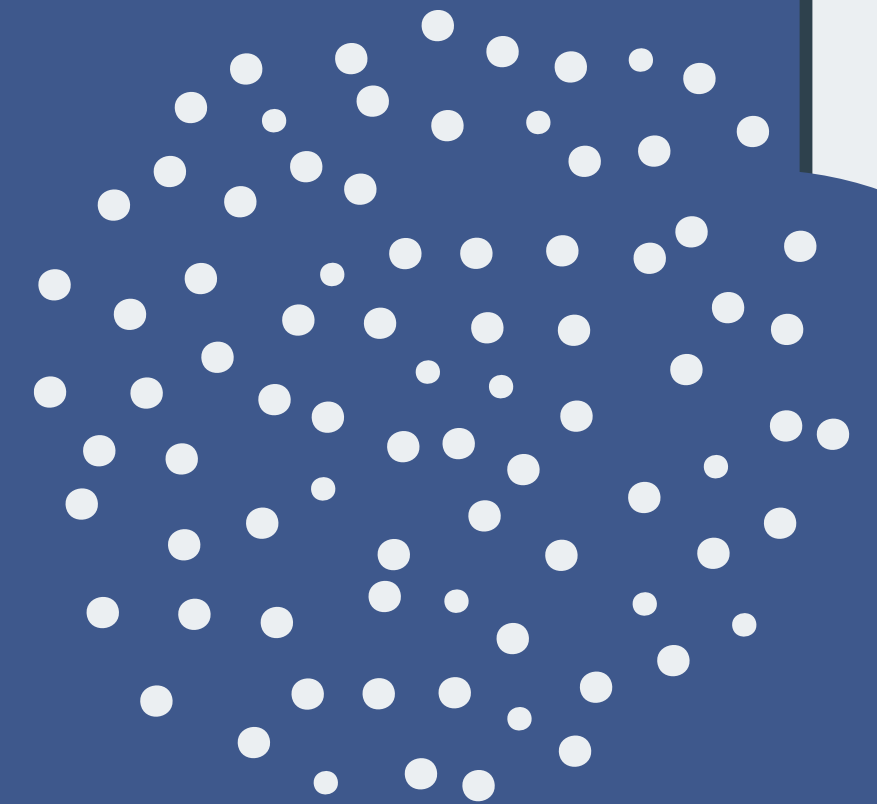
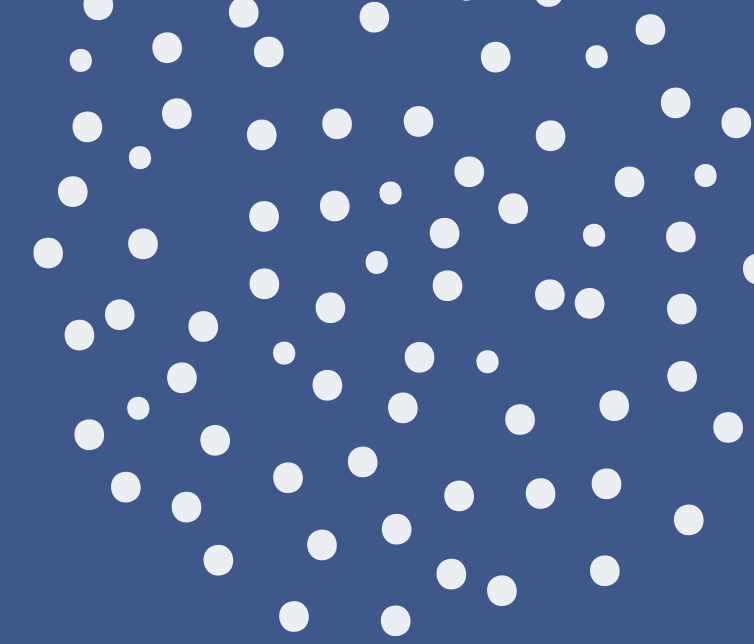

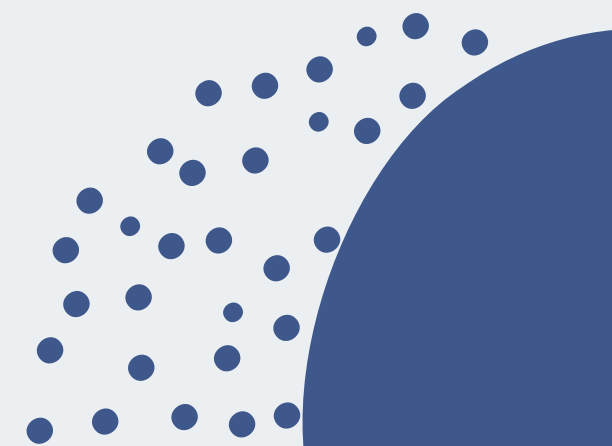

EU Cyber Standardization Strategy for Connectivity and Digital Infrastructure: Experience for Ukraine

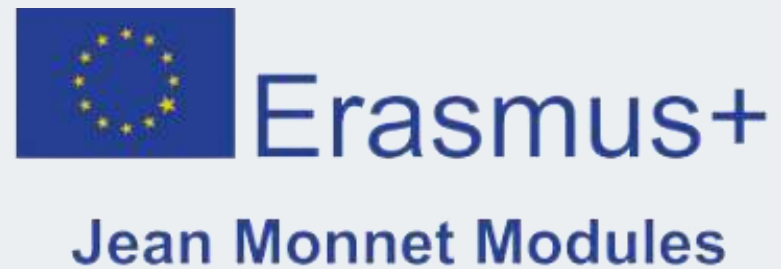

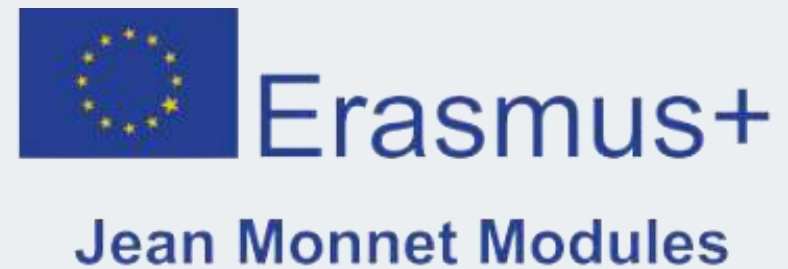

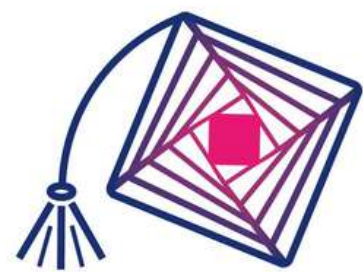
