**Assessment system**

Assessment forms and methods

The system for evaluating the developed competencies takes into account the types of classes that involve lectures, seminars, practical classes, as well as independent work. Assessment of students' developed competencies is carried out according to a cumulative 100-point system. The current control, which is carried out during the semester during practical (seminar) classes and independent work, is evaluated by the sum of points scored. The maximum possible number of points for the current and final control during the semester is 100, and the minimum possible number of points is 60. For the exam, the applicant can score a maximum of 40 points, the minimum possible number of points is 25.

Current control includes the following control measures: assignments by topic; business games, current test works; essay; creative tasks
