Assessment system of learning outcomes

The system of assessment of the formed competencies takes into account the types of classes, which include lectures, seminars, practical classes, as well as independent work. Assessment of the formed competencies of students is carried out according to the accumulative 100-point system. Current control, which is carried out during the semester during practical (seminar) classes and independent work is assessed by the sum of points scored. A student should be considered certified if the sum of points obtained from the final / semester performance test is equal to or exceeds 60. The minimum possible number of points for current and modul control during the semester is 35 and the minimum possible number of points scored in the exam is 25.

Current control includes the following control measures: tasks by topics; current control works; presentations on topics and essay writing.

More detailed information on the assessment and accumulation of points in the discipline is given in the working plan (technological card) of the discipline.
